

Number three “Seeing Angels”

A mass of material exists about angels appearing at the battle of Mons.
This is a daughter’s account of her father’s experience at that battle:

“My father won the military cross during that battle—how he won it I’ll never know, because he said it was too terrible to talk about.

There were about sixty thousand who went out to fight this battle and he told me ‘We were down to about thirty odd thousand...I can not give you the exact figures but...we were more than half left and the battle was getting impossible because the Germans had bigger and better equipment than us’.

My Father said he’d never experienced anything like it—they were dropping down like flies and all of a sudden there was an eerie sound and there was a white light across the hill and they saw these crowds on horses riding across the top of the hill. The Germans kept firing for a while but all of a sudden gave up. My father said they’d never seen anyone run as fast as these Germans over the hill and he told me ‘We were all awe-inspired and we looked up and said someone was doing some work.’

He said to me ‘Always be a Christian and believe in the Lord, because he saved us that day through the angels.’
